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Major Activities undertaken:

Skill Training and micro enterprise support:



MSEMVS has supported a number of families with skill training, small micro-enterprises and provided many livelihood alternatives to 303 Individuals and groups in 5 districts (Varanasi, Bhadohi, Mirzapur, Chandauli and Jaunpur) to start their micro business. With the support of MSEMVS the Individuals started their small enterprises i.e. carpet weaving, vegetable shops, Cosmetic Shop, Grocery shop, Chicken meat shop, Goat rearing, Duck Farming and many more works. Also, MSEMVS team provided training to every individual for growing their micro business.



School Project for educational support:

MSEMVS is implementing its education project through Transitional Schools/

Remedial coaching in the community of the most deprived section in the society. This project is implanting in 5 districts (Varanasi, Bhadohi, Chandauli, Mirzapur & Jaunpur) of Uttar Pradesh. This project works through strengthening the Education, Health and Livelihood. We convert the work time of the children to school time through remedial coaching. MSEMVS provides education to the children according to the standard of the government.



There are 23 remedial coaching centres running this year and major activities are as under -

- Providing education to the children of Vanvasi/Dalit Community mainly Brick Kiln Labour family children through remedial Coaching.
- Providing Nutrition and cooked food to the enrolled children of Remedial coaching.
- Supporting the families to enroll and retain the children in government school.
- Providing skill training to the community women and youths.
- Supporting community members in accessing the government services.
- Providing micro enterprises to the community members to work in decent working conditions.
- Educating community members about the government schemes and benefits.
- Supporting the community members in kitchen gardening.
- For the literacy of the community women, we organized a literacy class for women. We provided educational materials to the women and educated them to write their name in Hindi.

GoodWeave Child Friendly Communities (CFC)

The child Good Weave Child Friendly Communities aim to "ensure all the children up to the age of 14 years are not working and enjoy their rights to education and development."

The Child friendly community intervention is located in 55 communities of 4 regions namely Jaipur, Panipat, G. Noida and Varanasi of Northern India. The CFC program currently reaches 26,049 Children aged 06-14 years and 12,503 children aged 15-18 years.



The Major Activities/Achievement

- 33 Motivational learning centres operated on a regular basis to help at-risk children overcome their learning difficulties in all four regions. 33 MLCs provided remedial educational support to 2421 children to help them achieve age-appropriate language and numeracy skills, which resulted in an increased interest in school education. The MLCs also utilized an activity-based approach with TLM developed by the community facilitators using locally available material.
- 98 Child Parliament formed and facilitated in CFC villages. The members of Child Parliament were trained and active in conducting morning assemblies where children were encouraged to adopt new activities. The Child Parliament encouraged non-school going children to go to school. Child Parliament also contributed in tracking school attendance and addressing social issues such as girls education, child marriage, sanitation etc through regular class discussion or debates.
- 54 Bal Mitra Suraksha Samiti (BMSS) with a membership of averaging 12-15 members in each CFC community underwent the knowledge of weekly tracking of the children including support for the parents of at-risk children in order to send those children to school and MLC as well. A proportion of 12,490 children were tracked by BMSS too. More than 82% children were

made regular in school through school tracking, home visits, parents' meetings and engaging children in children parliament.

- Parents Teachers Meetings (PTMs): 382 meetings with parents about the importance of education and required support for promoting regular attendance of children with more than 4000 individuals.
- 192 Teaching Learning Materials (TLMs)TLMs demonstration classes were organized in government and Private schools in which a total of 4950 children participated
- 442 extra classes have been conducted in all CFCs of which 8551 children benefited from these classes. The GW team has provided support to schools in running the classes (government and private) in absence of teachers.
- 5106 children received books from MLC Library and the main objective was to improve the vocabulary and knowledge of children through promoting reading habits and students' knowledge of multiple subjects. The library also has a collection of storybooks to improve the vocabulary of students.
- 46 drawing competition sessions on children creativity at MLCs in which a total of 1356 children participated
- 847 Stories telling sessions done with 12685 children in the targeted communities





Strengthening Education, Health, Livelihood and Child Protection services.

This Project was implemented in 160 communities of 5 districts (Varanasi, Bhadohi, Mirzapur, Chandauli and Jaunpur). And major Activities of project are:

- Awareness and Support to the community members to access the government services.
- Facilitating the school enrolment campaign of Govt. and ensuring enrolment of never enrolled and dropout children from vulnerable families.
- Strengthen and Activation of School Management Committee. And trained SMC members on child Protection issues.
- Orient SMC for facilitating educational entitlement process (KYC issue, DBT process) at community level to block and district level.
- Sensitization of community on drop out children and role of SMC/SMDC to ensure retention of children in school.
- Convergence meeting with DCPU, Education, Social Welfare, and labour department, SMCs/SMDC, Bal Sansad, Parents etc at Block & District level.
- Support District Child Protection Unit for strengthening their monitoring process and reaching out to the most vulnerable children in the district.
- Orientation of PRI members for preparation of effective budget for Gram Panchayat and ensuring Child Protection component in Gram Panchayat Development Plan
- Training of Ward Members on utilisation of Child Protection budget through effective annual plan.
- Supporting vulnerable eligible families in accessing different livelihood options.
- Support health department to hold PMJAY camps/vaccination drives with NGO support in vulnerable communities.

Providing Education, Health and Livelihood training and services to mining affected families:

Project for education, health and livelihood of mining affected families living in 10 villages of Jamalpur block of Mirzapur district, Uttar Pradesh is being operated as per following activities and achievements-:

Major outcomes:

- 10 Child development resource centres set up in the project area have been operated twice a week by 10 youths, in which children are taught about school education, sports, child protection, yoga, creative activities and prevention of Covid-19 education.
- 10 children groups formed in the project ensured their 104 meetings. 12 to 15 children actively participated in these meetings. These children discussed education, health, environment and child protection issues in their meetings.
- MSEMVS, in collaboration with Anganwadi and Asha, has done kitchen gardening in the homes of more than 155 families. They did the cultivation of carrot, papaya, lettuce, mint, beet, giloy, aloe vera, basil, red chaurai, bitter gourd etc.
- 36 adolescent girls skilled in tailoring and 40 youth skilled in motor driving.

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Safe Migration in the GCC corridor:

The Project was implemented for providing education and counselling services to the labourers who migrate to Gulf countries. MSEMVS has provided the Safe Migration Tips training to the villagers in 30 villages in Mirzapur and Bhadohi districts through volunteers in collaboration of panchayats and front line service providers. PoE -Protector of Emigrants, in Uttar Pradesh regularly updated about the programmes undertaken in this project.





Major Activities and outcomes:

1. Training and workshop on Fees tracking method :

MSEMVS conducted 3 days cascade training on the fee tracking methods curriculum developed by Verité and one day workshop regarding survey for data collection.

2. 3 CVC cascade model training organized (2 in Bhadohi and 1 in Mirzapur) by Trained CVC members with the help of MSEMVS team. In This training altogether 82 CVC members from 6 CVC villages actively participated.

- 3. Migrant Vigilance committee (MVC) meeting : MSEMVS team conducted many 96 groups meeting with MVCs members in 15 villages (9 Villages in Mirzapur and 6 villages in Bhadohi districts). 114 MVCs members (62 Male and 52 Female) participated in these meetings. MSEMVS discussed about second phase of FFACT project, SAFE TIPS Guidance Dissemination, JWG app and recruitment fees tracking issues in these meetings.
- 4. Community Vigilance committee (CVC) meeting -MSEMVS Team conducted 128 groups meeting with CVCs members in 15 villages (9 Villages in Mirzapur and 6 villages in Bhadohi districts). 280 CVCs members (177 Male and 103 Female) participated in these meetings. MSMEVS team dissemination of SAFE TIPS Guidance.
- 5. Small group meetings with Village members:MSEMVS conducted 145 small group meetings (85 Mirzapur and 60 Bhadohi) with village members who are not part of CVC/MVC members. The team reached 919 individuals (683 Male and 256 Female) through these meetings in Mirzapur and Bhadohi districts.
- 6. 'Migrants Tracking Registers' were introduced in 30 villages (15 in Bhadohi & 15 in Mirzapur). The CVC leader of each CVC took the responsibility for updating the register on a daily basis. All the CVC members will share the information about potential migrant workers collected with the CVC leader and the CVC leader will add the data in the register. The data in the registers will be used for planning the training as well as for the advocacy activities by district level CVC.
- 7. According to the data collected in the tracking registers, MSEMS and CVC members initiated the process of briefing of the prospective migrant workers as well as family members of those migrant workers who are currently working in a gulf country. More than 200 Potential migrant workers were briefed in a group on safe tips guide by trained CVC leaders with the support to MSEMVS team.
- 8. 140 family members of migrant workers working currently in a gulf country were briefed one one one on the safe TIPS guide and 38 family members of migrant workers working currently were briefed in a group on safe tips guide by trained CVC leaders with the support to MSEMVS team.
- 9. Eight Awareness camps were conducted (Fivene in Bhadohi & three in Mirzapur) by CVC leaders with the help of MSEMVS team. In this camp approximately 3850 handbills were distributed to general people and around 1500 Individuals received the information about Safe TIPS.

Adult Literacy Program:

MSEMVS implement Adult literacy program (साक्षरता से सिद्धि) for illiterate communities in order to strengthen their effort as following objective:

- To make the community members literate through Digital literacy.
- To Strengthen the capacity of community members to run their micro enterprises and other entitlement by using literacy.
- To empower the community members to work independently through literacy.

• To make the changes of community members' lives by using literacy.

MSEMVS Implemented Adult literacy program in two villages of Bhadohi Mirzapur districts.

In the Adult Literacy Program we supported 60 learners, who had never ever been in school. We adopted an audio visual method provided by TCS (Tata Consultancy Services) to teach and made the learners able to read in a short time using a combination of method (through videos, text book, newspaper etc).



Major outcomes:

- 60% Learner able to identify the Hindi alphabets and able to read the simple words (2 to 4 letters simple words).
- 50% Learners are able to read day-to-day needs such as reading shop name, destination sign, Headline of newspaper, Bank Documents etc.
- Some learners are able to travel by themselves to any place by reading the destination sign of the road without any dependence.
- 50% Learners are able to calculate the wages, saving on their daily needs.
- Most of the learners identify the words and are able to write their name.
- Now learners realize the importance of education in life and they send their children to school every day inspired by the Adult Literacy Program. They helped their children in education.





Support to Community in Kitchen gardening -

For the better health of the community MSEMVS team promotes the community for kitchen gardening. MSEMVS team provide seed of green vegetable to the community members.



Collaboration and Support with Govt. departments:

- MSEMVS team supported Labour department in child labour survey in 25 villages of Gazipur district.
- MSEMVS supported Panchayati Raj on development of Gram Panchayat development plan and training on PRI on GPDP and child friendly Panchayat.
- MSEMVS has supported DCPUs, SJPUs, AHTUs, Labour Department and Education department in training, handholding support and IEC activities on a regular basis.
